### **PROFIT WARNING**

This announcement is made by Zhi Sheng Group Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 17.10 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on GEM (the “**GEM Listing Rules**”) of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined under the GEM Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board of directors of the Company (the “**Board**”) wishes to inform the shareholders and potential investors of the Company that based on the preliminary assessment of the information currently available, the Group expects to record an increase of more than 160% in loss attributable to the owners of the Company for the nine months ended 30 September 2020 as compared to the corresponding period last year, mainly attributable to the reduction of projects gross margin by the Group to increase its competitiveness, and due to the novel coronavirus epidemic, the Group offered lower price to obtain more orders to maintain effective operation. Although the revenue realized upon delivery of furniture products in the first three quarters of 2020 increased by over 40% as compared to the corresponding period last year, the overall realized gross profit still fell by more than 35% as compared to the corresponding period last year. Meanwhile, the Group recorded an increase of more than 40% in selling and distribution expenses as compared to the corresponding period last year, mainly due to the impact of the novel coronavirus outbreak which lead to significant increases in installation and transportation costs, loading fees and travel expenses during the period. Besides, administrative and other expenses also increased by around 50% as compared to the corresponding period last year, mainly attributable to (1) the amortisation of the intangible assets arising from acquisition of Polyqueue Limited (“**Polyqueue Data Center**”), (2) the legal and professional fees paid for acquisition of Polyqueue Data Center, (3) increases in provision for bad debt receivables and inventory losses, and (4) the significant increase in the cost of purchasing epidemic prevention supplies and employee welfare expenses. The financing costs on the new working capital loan of RMB30 million incurred this year and interest expenses on convertible bonds newly incurred also led to a further increase in the Company’s losses.

In addition, the Group completed the acquisition of Polyqueue Data Center during the period. It has become a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company and its financial results have been consolidated into the financial statements of the Group since 15 January 2020. It is expected that its financial results from the acquisition date up to 30 September 2020 will have a positive impact on the Group's financial performance. (Details of the acquisition were disclosed in the Company's announcements dated 21 October 2019, 11 November 2019 and 12 December 2019, the circular dated 13 December 2019 and the announcement dated 15 January 2020.)

The Company is still in the process of finalizing the Group's results for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The information contained in this announcement is only based on the preliminary assessment by the Board with reference to the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group and the information currently available, and is not based on any figures or information which have been audited or reviewed by the auditor or the audit committee of the Company. Actual results of the Group for the nine months ended 30 September 2020 may be different from those disclosed in this announcement. Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are advised to read carefully the results announcement of the Company for the nine months ended 30 September 2020, which is expected to be published in mid-November 2020.
